BOUNDARY CONSULTATION

Thank you to all those residents who returned the consultation papers supporting our campaign.

The Council made its Final Recommendations on the Review at its Annual Meeting on 23rd May 2018. These included the creation of a new parish for Waverley with a parish council, to be known as Waverley Community Council. There will be elections to the new parish council and to Catcliffe and Orgreave Parish Councils in May 2019 and the councillors elected would serve until May 2024. The Local Government Boundary Commission for England gave their consent to the making of an Order.

The next step is for the Council to decide whether to implement the Final Recommendations by making an Order, which would include a figure for the budget of the new parish council for 2019/20 because the budget and Council Tax precept have to be decided before the election of the new councillors in May 2019.

We will keep you updated in due course.
